GETTING STARTED

On Arrival

- **Activate** and manage your Oxford SSO (Single Sign-On) account at <https://webauth.ox.ac.uk>
- Access your Oxford email account at <https://outlook.office.com/>
- Book into meals in the Hall at <https://epos.merton.ox.ac.uk>

Web/email access pre-registration

- Should you need to get online in order to activate accounts and set passwords, 'Kiosk' computers are located in the **Mob Library** but must be booked in advance.

Wireless Network Access

- Use "eduroam" available across Oxford.
- Your **username** is usually entered in the form: 'mert1234@OX.AC.UK'
- Your **password** is your Remote Access password: <https://register.it.ox.ac.uk>

Computer Rooms

- **Owl & Mob Libraries, Holywell A block basement - check the intranet to see which are currently open**
- Logon using your Oxford SSO username & password (SSO; also known as your Oxford IT account).
